Bring one of the following and you will receive up to 4 bingo cards:



Can/boxed food item (please check expiration dates before bringing)

MAINTNANCE REQUESTS



All work orders must be put in the work order station. Please do not stop Joe and ask him to do things, no matter how quick you think it can be done. He is working on orders that are already in the system. To explain it further, all work order requests go to Calamar. When Joe completes his weekly time sheet, all work orders are tallied. If Joe states he changed 12 light bulbs for 10 apartments, but his boss sees only 2 apartments needed light bulbs it creates a problem with the accounting system and the inventory. It also makes it difficult for Joe as he is trying to get his assigned jobs done. A recent example is: Joe went up to complete a work order. On his way, he was stopped 5 times by residents who asked if he could do this or that stating it will only take a minute. By the time Joe arrived at the apartment to complete the work order, he was delayed.
