Dear Auburn Grove Residents,

September has been a month of transition, some of our residents have moved to other locations and we wish them well. We also have some new tenants moving in and I know that you will make them feel comfortable and welcome. Our new residents are: Linda Ricci in Apt. # 235 and Linda Hoey in Apt. # 108.

Our theme this year is "Hats and Mittens and Scarves! Oh My!" for our Christmas Tree entry for the Festival of Trees at the Agricultural Museum. We will be collecting donations of hats, gloves, mittens and scarves which will be donated to a charity. For every item donated we will place an ornament (shaped like a hat or mitten, glove or scarf) on our tree. We will be holding a **fire drill on Thursday, October 26th at 3:30 pm, all residents** are expected to exit the building and go to their appropriate zone by the parking lot when they hear the alarms go off. Those who are physically impaired please go to your refuge zone in the stairwell. If you are going to the stairwell (refuge zone) you may want to bring some ear plugs with you so that the alarms don't bother you too much. You may tape a pair to the inside of your front door so that they are always available should the alarm sound.

We need more people to sign up to help with coffee hour on Fridays so that the same people don't have to do it. Please sign up if you can help, it would be appreciated. The signup sheet is in the lobby.

Just to remind you, that we will be doing inspections, changing the filters, and changing the batteries in the thermostats and the smoke alarms in October. The 1st floor apartments will be done on Thursday, 10/5; the 2nd floor apartments on Thursday, 10/12; and then the 3rd floor apartments 2 weeks later Thursday, 10/26. We will be entering the apartment whether you are home or not; if you want to be there, please make sure you are there on the appropriate date. We will be starting at 9:30 am on each of the days.

There will also be a signup sheet in the lobby for our Election Day Bake Sale. If you can donate a baked good, we would really appreciate it. The monies are used by our Activities Committee to subsidize dinners and other events for our residents. We need cakes, pies, cupcakes, brownies, cookies, breads, etc. They can be delivered to the kitchen by 3 pm on Monday, 11/6.
