#### FIRST THANKSGIVING DINNER

The Wampanoag tribe of Native Americans helped the Pilgrims survive their first year in the New World, and they celebrated together in the autumn of 1621 with a holiday feast. Information comes from a letter written in December 1621 by Edward Winslow. He was one of the who sailed from England in 1620 that founded Plymouth Colony in Mass. According to Winslow, it was considered a harvest celebration and took place over 3 days sometime between late Sept. and mid Nov. in 1621. They ate wild turkey, venison (Native Americans Brought this), fish and shellfish, wild plants. They also ate foods from their gardens.
