

1/1 New Year's Day is the most celebrated holiday around the world (45 B.C.)

1/3 Alaska was admitted as the 49th US state with a land mass almost one-fifth the size of the lower 48 states together (1959)

1/7 A patent was issued for the first typewriter designed by British inventor Henry Mill for the impressing or transcribing of letters singly or progressively one after another, as in writing (1714)

1/10 An Amendment granting women the right to vote was introduced in Congress by Senator A.A. Sargent of California. The amendment didn't pass until 1920, forty-two years later (1878)

1/12 The war against Irag began as Allied aircraft conducted a major raid against Iragi air defenses. The air raid on Baghdad was broadcast live to a global audience by CNN correspondents as operation Desert Shield became Desert Storm (1991)

1/25 An American Airlines Boeing 707 made the first scheduled transcontinental US flight, traveling from California to New York (1959)
